Baseline Data

We have been tracking Chronic Absenteeism attendance data since 2019. In the 2021-2022 school year, we implemented a new program called Here and Now. This is an incentive program that is supported by our conesite, community businesses and faculty. The data chart on page 2 shows the percentages in each attendance category through the years. The first year we implemented as a school alone, the 2nd year we brought the High School on board and worked with the Middle School to share ideas and encourage them to help us make this a cone-site wide program. Through that experience, we found that some tweaks were needed to accommodate both Intermediate/Middle and High School needs, but we've found what works at each level and are continuing to encourage students to make good choices regarding school attendance.

How does this project support the School Improvement Plan?

Good school attendance is a goal in our School Improvement Plan. Students who attend school will have better outcomes and better access to educational advantages than those who do not.

How will achieving this goal lead to significant and meaningful outcomes for students?

Students need to be at school in order to learn academic, social, and emotional skills for future sucess. Students who are not at school regularly have higher rates of negative outcomes compared to those who do, namely lower reading and acheivement scores, higher dropout rates, higher involvment with court system, increased social struggles, school avoidance & anxiety (www.attendanceworks.com, 2017).

Systemic Interventions				
Individual Level	Students can earn incentives through good attendance by earning the Here & Now Card. Anyone who has been at school 95% of the time will earn this card and be eligible for incentives and celebrations.			
Student Group Level	Students who do not meet the 95% goal will work with our attendance coach and/or counselors to set attendance goals and work to earn the Here and Now rewards. These students may also take our Here and Now Attendance Success course.			
Classroom Level	All students are given Attendence Success Coursework at beginning of year. Classroom teachers offer incentives such as: school store points, extra credit, homework passes, classroom rewards for students who have earned the card.			
Grade Level	Occasionally, grade level competitions will be held to encourage participation and motivate students in a friendly, competetive way.			
School Level	Schoolwide celebrations are held for those who have the card, have set goals to earn the card, have Practicially Perfect attendance, or other school attendance goals. These celebrations happen quarterly and at the end of the semester and school year.			
District Level	Cone-site wide participation with the Intermediate, Middle and High Schools helps to get the word out into the community that attendance is important and that our schools have the same expectation throughout their secondary school experience.			
Family Level	We regularly send home materials to educate parents about the importance of good school attendance through our monthly newsletters, counselor website, emails, and other communications. We send a tracker so that absences can be more easily monitored and accounted for.			
Community Level	We have strong support from our local business community who believe that good school attendance fosters good & necessary workplace skills. They have offered rewards and discounts to support school attendance goals. Sponsors include Harmons, Arcadia, Handel's Ice Cream, Dutchman's, and Lightfoots. We will recruit throughout the year and summer.


Results/Outcome Statement

Did you meet your goal?

Chronic absentee rates dropped from 41.7% to 25.07% and Severe Chronic rates dropped from 13.53% to 5.07% which far surpassed our goal. Regular attendance rates also rose from 31.82% to 41.74%.

Reflection: Project Outcome Analysis

This is the first year in over 7 years of tracking attendance data that we have seen a positive outcome and a reduction in chronic absenteeism rates. Our Tier 1 attendance lessons may have been one reason for the change. We saw very positive results when we used the Attendance course in small groups (see last year's data project) and decided to implement school wide. We have also been consistent in honoring the value of the cards and continuing to garner support of the program.



Reflection: Learning and Next Steps

We are very glad to have the middle school on board and are looking forward to building some continuity as our students continue to utilize the Here & Now program at all levels. We want to build our list of sponsors so that we might have different sponsors from one semester to the other. We also want to increase consistent in-school rewards throughout the year. This will help us reach students who may not have the means to visit the community sponsors around town. We will continue to focus on those near our school to that end as well.
